The region is in a crisis and the new and next generation cannot afford to live and work here without bold change.

I support the proposed plan to develop Brisbane's Baylands site with a well-designed plan that includes both residential and commercial MAXIMUM uses.

My understanding the current plan includes 4,400 units of housing. I would encourage both more housing and more office by increasing height and more underground parking where possible.

This is a unique opportunity to build a sustainable community of offices, laboratories, eateries, and retailers, while providing natural habitats, biking trails and extensive open space. It will benefit the local community with a new grocery store and pharmacy, dedicate land for a local school and provide 300 acres of restored and enhanced habitats. It will help the surrounding community as well by providing 4,400 units or more of much-needed housing, as we face a crippling housing shortage. These new units will help reduce greenhouse gas emissions by providing housing close to job centers.
