Dredge Update 8-14-2016

- Dredging is continuing on Dock 5, and <u>soon will involve dock 6</u>. We will call you as soon as we have a temporary slip for you, and once dredging is finished in your "home" slip area, you will be called once we get word you can move back. PLEASE DO NOT move back unless you are asked to do so; please move "home" ASAP once notified to free up temp. slips for the next cycle.
- Dredgers should be routinely contacted on Marine radio band Channel 80, IF they are present when you need to move- and you are advised to contact them anytime they are working and you are moving in or out of the Marina. (They also monitor Ch. 16). Sometimes, a few minutes may be needed to relocate their equipment- they are able to better respond when you give 15-20 minutes notice before moving. Slow, safe vessel moves in all Marina areas are requested.
- Dredgers are moving on Wednesday 8-17 by 6 AM to the South side of the North finger of Dock 5 to include slips 5001 to 5052. Boaters in this area will be contacted with a temporary slip assignment as soon as we have a temporary available. FOLLOWING phase starting Fri., 8-19 at 6AM is Dock 5, slips 5A, 5B, 5005-5053, AND dock 6 slips 6010, 6011, 6012, 6014. We will advise of temporary slip assignments as soon as we are able to find one for you.
- After this phase of Dock 5 is complete- we will empty the slips on ENTIRE Dock 6/7 area at once. Again- you will be contacted as soon as possible once we are advised of possible moves.
