SUBJECT: Certification of Results of General Municipal Election, November 7, 2017
to fill three Council seats for three-year terms

Recommendation:

Adopt Resolution No. 2017-61 adopting the County of San Mateo's Certification of Votes and Declaring Results of the General Municipal Election held on November 7, 2017 to fill three City Council seats.

Background:

On June 1, 2017, the Brisbane City Council adopted Ordinance 620 changing future City Council elections from odd-numbered years to even-numbered years. To make this transition, the City held its regular elections in November 2017 and will hold a regular election in November 2019, electing Councilmembers to serve three-year terms.

At the same City Council meeting, the City Council also called an election to submit to the voters the candidates to fill three City Council three-year terms.

Discussion:


The attached Resolution declares the results of the election that was held on November 7, 2017.

W. Clarke Conway, Karen Cunningham and Cliff Lentz were elected to serve on the City Council through December 2020.

In Brisbane, this year's voter turnout was 44.4%, compared to 2015 at 48.2%, 2013 at 48.1%, 2011 at 41%, and 2009 at 37.8%.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRISBANE
ADOPTING COUNTY OF SAN MATEO CERTIFICATION OF VOTES
AND DECLARING RESULTS TO FILL THREE COUNCIL SEATS AT THE
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 2017**

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held in and throughout the City of Brisbane on the seventh day of November, 2017, to submit the candidates to fill three Council seats for three-year terms to the qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of said City has duly posted and presented to the City Council of the City of Brisbane the County of San Mateo's certification of the votes cast in said General Municipal Election; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has access to and has examined said certification of votes cast in said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Brisbane finds as follows:

1. The total number of votes cast was 1170.
2. That the record of votes cast in said election is shown on Exhibit "A" of the Certificate of the Chief Elections Official, attached hereto, and by such reference made a part hereof.
3. That W. Clarke Conway, Karen Cunningham and Cliff Lentz were elected to fill the offices of Councilmember for a term ending in December 2020 and the City Clerk is hereby directed to issue a Certificate of Election to the persons, certifying each person's election to the office appearing after his or her name, and to administer to the elected persons the oath of office prescribed by the Constitution of the laws of the State of California.
