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## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Brisbane Planning Commission on **Tuesday, February 27, 2018, at 7:30 p.m., Brisbane City Hall, 50 Park Place, Brisbane**, to consider the following matter:

ZONING:                    **C-1 Commercial Mixed Use District (Baylands)**

REQUEST:                 **Interim Use Permit for a 5 year term to allow for outdoor storage/staging of up to 750 rental, passenger vehicles for Avis Budget Group on a vacant, approximately 4.8 acre portion of the Baylands, located behind (immediately east of) the Transdev bus yard, as a temporary overflow lot for vehicles rented through San Francisco International Airport (SFO).**

STATUS:                   **This project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Sections 15304(e) of the CEQA Guidelines. The exceptions to these categorical exemptions, referenced in Section 15300.2, do not apply.**
