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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Brisbane Planning Commission on **Tuesday, May 8, 2018**, at 7:30 p.m., Brisbane City Hall, 50 Park Place, Brisbane, to consider the following matter:

APPLICATION NO.: Use Permit UP-2-18

APPLICANT/OWNER: Kory Kaplan (CRB Architects-Engineers), applicant/
Marina Boulevard Property Llc, owner.

LOCATION: 7000 Marina Boulevard
(Assessor's Parcel No. 007-165-120)

ZONING: SP-CRO Sierra Point Commercial District

REQUEST: Use Permit to modify the parking regulations prescribed in the Off-Street Parking ordinance, to allow the parking for the existing building to be reduced to 245 parking spaces whereas 268 spaces would otherwise be required, for the conversion of the building from administrative office to administrative office and research & development.

ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS: Categorical Exemption per State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(a) & (e) - this project falls within a class of projects which the State has determined not to have a significant effect on the environment. The exceptions to this categorical exemption referenced in Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines do not apply.

If you challenge the application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Any attendee who wishes accommodation for a disability should contact the Community Development Department at least forty-eight hours prior to the meeting.
