There seems to be some confusion over this statement in the Notice of Public Hearing:

"The City Council will consider, if it approves the General Plan Amendment, a ballot measure placing the General Plan Amendment on the Nov 2018 ballot for voter consideration."

I think that it would have been more clear to have stated something like: "If the City Council approves a draft of the General Plan Amendment, a ballot measure seeking binding voter approval of said General Plan Amendment will be placed on the November ballot."

English is a tricky language and can so easily be misinterpreted. Can you please clarify exactly what that statement means? What exactly is the process, step-by-step, and will the vote of the public, "Yes, accept the amendment," or "No, do not accept the amendment" be binding?

Clay, is there a map that should accompany the Public Hearing notice? Please publish that as soon as possible, if you would.
