Emergencies at the Marina: We had a boater lose consciousness and fall in the water last week. He was stopped from sinking (while unconscious!) by his wife, who grabbed his shirt and called out for help. A boater on a nearby dock paddled his kayak over to help remove the man from the water. 911 was called, and the fire trucks arrived—but, remember- we in the office are MUCH closer and can always come help!



IF there is an emergency **Please make us your second call** (put our # on speed dial, 650-583-6975) during regular work hours and we can come down to help (probably) before emergency services arrive!

APRIL UPDATE Live-aboard permit application:

As you know, we have *applied to BCDC for approval* to be a "live-aboard" marina. We still have **NO idea on the possible approval TIMELINE**. There is no "LIST" at this time and we will post updates as this changes. IF we are approved, boaters to be considered for this status will be those who ALREADY have a boat here.

From Teresa:

- When selling a boat, the transfer of a slip is NOT automatic! Many boats are currently in certain length slips that are on a "wait list," and we must honor the list first before considering letting a new owner stay in a certain slip... we can almost always find a slip for new owners, it just may not be the same old one. One a similar note—30 day notice MUST be given when vacating a slip, and all keys returned in order to obtain a full refund.
- When you renew your California registration, remember to bring the new document to the office and apply your 2019 stickers to your hull. We STILL have a number of boats showing WAY expired CF #'s, and we will have Brisbane PD walk the docks to issue citations. Please also bring a new copy of your insurance policy when you renew.
