UPDATE: BCDC LIVE-ABOARD PERMIT APPLICATION

The City has received BCDC's approval for "live-aboards," and the City Council began consideration of this item at their 7/19/18 meeting. The City must now decide on a fee schedule for live aboard boats, and will consider this in the next Council meeting.

There is *no "list" at this time* and we will post updates as this changes. The boaters to be first considered for this status will be those who have *already* had a boat here for 6 months. **REMEMBER: IF we are approved- all those who** *may need* **to update their status SHOULD convert to the liveaboard, as we will be MUCH more vigilant on the "3-night" rule going forward.**

The **2018 Kite Festival is planned for Saturday, August 4th!** There will be food and beverages for sale, provided by our partners at the Sierra Point Yacht Club. Additionally, there will be music, face painting, representatives from Parks and Recreation will be here to give away kites for those needing them, a cool old Fire truck to climb on, the Brisbane Police will have a booth, and we will have an "escape this truck" attraction set up as well... **COME FLY WITH US!**


Our door is always open, and we are grateful that you have chosen Brisbane Marina as your "home port!"
