### SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 07/01 Brisbane Marina Vehicle Theft  
The reporting party advised that between 06/30/10 and 07/01/10 an unknown subject took his 1990 Ford van. The vehicle was entered into SVS. This case has been suspended pending further leads or suspect information. Report #10-0701-0002.
- 07/02 Unit block of Visitacion Public Intoxication

Due to her demeanor it was determined that she was not a suitable candidate for First Chance.
