## **2.) PHASED CLEAN-UP ?**

**During the 1/28/16 meeting on Basic principles it was suggested to allow phased clean-up. This is unconscionable.**

**There are several endangerment orders on several properties out there. It is the lead agency's responsibility to get a plan for cleanup. The toxins still leak into the Bay in spite of interim measures, so a plan to not clean up is unacceptable. We have been waiting for a "plan" for over twenty years.**

**Even the language of large unbroken blocks of open space may be questionable if you don't make certain that it, the Open Space, is clean and healthy and part of an integrated environmental design. Isolated open space is meaningless.**

**Additionally, the applicant has said that we get 300 acres of open space in the form of the lagoon. This calculation- rather TRICK - should not be allowed. The lagoon is another district, it is not land, it is not the Baylands. It is also something that cannot be changed because it's waters of the State and we, the public own the Lagoon's edge.**

### 3.) Define "Rail-related Activities"

**It is important to be careful with this language. A kiosk about the trains could fit the bill as well as a railyard to store crude oil tankers. It needs to indicate the public's desire for a train museum... not just "rail-related" activity.**
