PUMPKIN TIME, AGAIN!

Well, the Fall has fallen and the nights are getting cooler. The first storm is due this weekend. Have you visited your boat lately to clean her up, and check your dock lines and cleats before the Winter storms roll in? **PLEASE** do so!

- There has been a bit of confusion about the pigeon trapping project. If you see a cage on the docks with pigeons inside, **please leave it** as-is. The birds are NOT pets, they are being collected for relocation in order to keep your boats cleaner. I also want to remind all that we are actively **trapping RATS** and we are doing our best to improve the situation on the docks. It appears that at least one VERY odiferous skunk has established residency near the SPYC building—and we will soon initiate trapping for the skunks and for the raccoons as well.

Ongoing /pending projects updates:

- We are accepting bids for the repairs to the walls in the South public restrooms
- We are continuing the dock renewal project, currently working on dock 6
- The missing channel markers will be replaced before the end of November
- The parking area near the office is due to be resealed, with new parking space lines painted this Spring
- We have had a few signal issues with the WiFi, and are working on solutions

Please be sure to secure your equipment and vessel, as we continue to have sporadic reports of thefts on the docks. At least two large fuel thefts have been reported—so if you see someone either siphoning or pumping fuel off a vessel—especially at night, **CALL IT IN!**

We are in the process of hiring new night Public Service Aides to patrol the docks and lots, as we have lost several due to retirement- and we should have full, 7-day night shift coverage again soon. **Remember to call Brisbane Police ANYTIME you see someone or something out of the ordinary.** They are happy to come and provide police service at the Marina.


IF you have a collision...



*Stuff happens, right? If there are no injuries, think of an accident here as a “fender bender,” no big deal to report and fix. The boater responsible for this accident was responsive and responsible, contacting us right away with the details of the incident so we could notify the other boater and hook up the two owners’ insurance companies. Marina policy requires that you notify us **ASAP in writing** of any accident causing injuries, damage to a boat or to our facilities in the Marina. If you can imagine this, we recently had a boater **refuse** to provide insurance info to another owner– as he disputed the events of the accident. The insurance companies can always investigate the details... PLEASE **do the right thing and take responsibility** when necessary– thanks!*
