City Council Goals:

To provide public service that assures the safety of property and citizens residing, working or visiting in Brisbane. (Goal #9)

Recommendation:

That the City Council adopt Resolution 2018-06 amending building permit fees for non-residential rooftop solar installations.

Background/Discussion:

The City of Brisbane's adopted building permit fee schedule establishes building permit fees for nonresidential rooftop solar installations as a percentage of the value of the system being installed. Assembly Bill 1414 which took effect on January 1, 2018 establishes maximum building permit fees for nonresidential solar installations as follows:

• \$1,000 for systems up to 50 kilowatt (kW), plus \$7/kilowatt for each kW between 51kW and 250kW, plus \$5/kilowatt per kW above 251kW

It is recommended that the City's building permit fee schedule be amended consistent with the provisions of state law.
