Notes from the Harbormaster

I am responsible for making announcements and forwarding staff requests + providing you info on all that is happening here. This month, the majority of items come from your fellow BOATERS:

- PLEASE **STOP riding BICYCLES on the docks!** This is prohibited in the Marina regulations and IF there is ever a collision on the dock that results in a complaint or injury, and you were on your bike- you may be asked to leave the Marina, in addition to any civil penalties, etc..
- PLEASE <u>do not berth or spend the night</u> at the PUMP OUT DOCK. Apparently there are a couple of boaters who do this every week. That dock is for pumping out ONLY- please go to our GUEST dock if you need a temporary berth for the night!
- **MOSQUITOS** are a real issue this year! Please check your boat and eliminate any source of standing water. We have had many complaints that our "derelict" fleet is responsible, due to a lack of attention to our vessels & we have huge numbers of reports of bites on the docks this season.


<u>And this leads to my final point</u>- for MONTHS I have been advising that it is IMPORTANT to keep your registration current & bring us a copy for your file. ALL vessels lacking proper registration or that are NOT SEAWORTHY will be receiving correction requests from me. *Take these as serious warnings*. Our desirability as a destination Marina is increasing and we want well maintained and seaworthy boats in every slip. PLEASE do your part!

UPDATE : BCDC LIVE-ABOARD PERMIT APPLICATION

The City has received BCDC's approval for "live-aboards," and the City Council began consideration of this item at their 7/19/18 meeting. The City must now decide on a fee schedule for live aboard boats, and will consider this at an upcoming Council meeting. There is *no "list" at this time* and we will post updates as this changes. The boaters to be first considered for this status will be those who have *already* had a boat here for 6 months.

Our door is always open, and we are grateful that you have chosen Brisbane Marina as your "home port!"
