City Council Goals:

To provide for effective and efficient delivery of City services. (#1)

Purpose:

To obtain Council's approval to declare an outboard motor as surplus, and authorize the City Manager to dispose of this equipment.

Recommendation:

Approve Resolution No. 2017-42

Background:

From time to time, certain equipment the city owns reaches a state where it is no longer economically feasible to repair, is simply obsolete, or is no longer needed for use by the city. The equipment described in the attached Resolution was obtained by the city along with a boat that was turned in for destruction under the Surrendered and Abandoned Vessel Exchange (SAVE) Program, under which the Marina manages funding from the Division of Boating and Waterways to remove, reduce and prevent abandoned recreational vessels. Staff believes the equipment has some residual value, and recommends offering it for sale via sealed bids.

Discussion:

There is no recommended alternative to the one proposed above. If the city does not receive reasonable bids for the equipment, then the City Manager has authority to donate it or recycle it.

In the event Council approves the recommended action, staff has prepared a Notice Inviting Bids to be posted in our legally required places of notice. A Sealed Bid Form has also been prepared.

Fiscal Impact:

Some revenue, albeit a small amount, is anticipated to be received from the sale of this vessel.

Measure of Success

City equipment disposed of in accordance with applicable laws.
