







### Q8x3 How often do you feel the following?

























### Q16x2 How likely is it that you will provide unpaid care to an adult loved one in the future?





### Q16x3 What is the highest level of education that you completed?





### Q16x4 Are you of Hispanic, Spanish, or Latino origin or descent?





### Q16x5 Which language do you prefer to speak?





### Q16x6 What race do you consider yourself?


