A. Update to Housing Element (Continued from June 29, 2009)

After staff presentation and Council discussion the following speakers gave public comment:

CM Conway made a motion, seconded by CM Barnes to make the following changes to the current zoning to meet the Regional Housing Number Allocation (RHNA) of 401 units as required by the State of California:

- ~~Line 8~~—Specify a Minimum Density of 20 units/acre in the R-2 district
- ~~Line 9~~—Specify a Minimum Density of 20 units/acre in the R-3 district
- ~~Line 11~~—Rezone half of the first block of San Bruno Avenue to R-3
- ~~Line 12~~—Rezone the Southern portion of Southwest Bayshore to R-3 at 20 units per acre minimum, with land dedication requirements
- ~~Line 15~~—Rezone to Mobile Home Uses Only the Existing Mobile Home Park at 29 units per acre minimum

The motion was carried by all present.

The Goals, Policies and Programs Review was continued to a Council meeting in September.
